In this declaratory judgment action, seeking attorney's fees and injunctive relief,

plaintiffs have commenced four separate and identical actions on behalf of four plaintiffs before

three justices. Specifically, the four actions are:

Fischer v. 250 East Houston Street Associates, LP., No. 160624/2018 (before Justice W. Franc Perry)

LePage v. 250 East Houston Street Associates, LP., No. 161131/2018 (before Justice James Edward D'Auguste)

Day v. 250 East Houston Street Associates, LP., No. 161897/2018 (before Justice James Edward D'Auguste)

Forepaugh v. 250 East Houston Street Associates, LP., No. 160660/2018 (before Justice Lynn R. Kotler)

On April 8, 2019, plaintiffs in each of the four cases moved to amend the complaints to add non-party 250 Houston Investors, L.P. ("Investors") as a defendant. Thereafter, on June 24, 2019, Investors opposed each of the motions and cross-moved for consolidation and sanctions in each of the cases. Plaintiffs do not oppose the portion of Investors' cross-motions seeking consolidation of all four cases before a single justice, as all four cases state identical causes of
