

stand, the manner of testifying, and the reasonableness of the testimony, the court finds that plaintiff was not injured as a direct or proximate result of defendant's negligence. The court finds that such a minor impact was insufficient to cause plaintiff's alleged injuries. Her back problems, if any, were pre-existing and were not exacerbated by defendant's actions.

For the foregoing reasons, judgment is rendered in favor of defendant on the issue of damages. Court costs are assessed against plaintiff. The clerk shall serve upon all parties notice of this judgment and its date of entry upon the journal.
