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THE COURT FINDS THAT:

{¶ 1} 1) On September 23, 2004, plaintiff, Richard M. DeLon, filed a complaint against defendant, Ohio Highway Patrol, alleging defendant's employee damaged plaintiff's car. Plaintiff seeks damages in the amount of \$332.38 for automotive repair costs. Plaintiff submitted the filing fee with his complaint;

{¶ 2} 2) On November 9, 2004, defendant filed an investigation report admitting liability and acknowledging plaintiff suffered damages in the amount of \$332.38, plus filing fee reimbursement;

{¶ 3} 3) On November 19, 2004, plaintiff filed a response expressing his agreement with defendant's proposal.

THE COURT CONCLUDES THAT:

{¶ 4} 1) I find, by a preponderance of the evidence, negligence by defendant has been shown. *Baisden v. Southern Ohio Correctional Facility* (1977), 76-0617-AD; *Stewart v. Ohio National Guard* (1979), 78-0342-AD;

{¶ 5} 2) Plaintiff as suffered damages in the amount of \$332.38, plus the \$25.00 filing fee, which may be reimbursed as compensable damages pursuant to the holding in *Bailey v. Ohio Department of*

Rehabilitation and Correction (1990), 62 Ohio Misc. 2d 19.
