 $\{\P 1\}$ On April 27, 2009, the magistrate issued a decision recommending judgment for defendant.

 $\{\P 2\}$ Civ.R. 53(D)(3)(b)(i) states, in part: "A party may file written objections to a magistrate's decision within fourteen days of the filing of the decision, whether or not the court has adopted the decision during that fourteen-day period as permitted by Civ.R. 53(D)(4)(e)(i)."

{¶ 3} On May 14, 2009, plaintiff filed his objections. Upon review, the court finds both that while plaintiff's objections were not timely filed, they would not, in any event, be well-taken.
