ENTRY OF DISMISSAL STATE HIGHWAY PATROL

{¶ 1} On September 3, 2010, defendant filed a motion to dismiss, stating this claim was paid by Ohio Department of Administrative Services. On July 28, 2010, check no. 14737124 in the amount of \$125.96, was sent to plaintiff as a full and final release of the claim against defendant. Plaintiff has not responded to defendant's motion to dismiss.
