S.Ct.Prac.R. 2.2(A)(1)(a) ("To perfect an appeal from a court of appeals to the Supreme Court, \* \* \* the appellant shall file a notice of appeal in the Supreme

Court within forty-five days from the entry of the judgment being appealed"). Pesci's Civ.R. 60(B) motion for relief from judgment did not extend his time to appeal the judgment, and Pesci could not use Civ.R. 60(B) as a substitute for a timely appeal. *State ex rel. Manuel v. Stenson*, 126 Ohio St.3d 52, 2010-Ohio-2673, 930 N.E.2d 310, citing *State ex rel. Martin v. Ohio Adult Parole Auth.*, 124 Ohio St.3d 63, 2009-Ohio-6164, 918 N.E.2d 1005.
