ON APPLICATION FOR REINSTATEMENT.

{¶ 1} This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of an application for reinstatement by respondent, James Sidney Jones, Attorney Registration No. 0064099, last known address in Boardman, Ohio.

{¶ 2} The court coming now to consider its order of August 25, 2011, wherein the court found respondent in contempt of its December 16, 2010 order, revoked the stay of his suspension, and suspended him for failing to pay board costs, finds that respondent has substantially complied with that order and with the provisions of Gov.Bar R.
