 $\{\P 2\}$ The court coming now to consider its order of September 12, 2003, wherein the court found respondent in contempt for failing to comply with its October 2, 2002 order, revoked the previously imposed stay of the suspension, and suspended respondent from the practice of law for a period of one year, finds that respondent has substantially complied with that order and with the provisions of Gov.Bar R. V(24).

 $\{\P 3\}$ Therefore, it is ordered by this court that respondent is reinstated to the practice of law in the state of Ohio.
