As allowed under ORS 19.205(2), and explained in *Stanwood v. Multnomah County*, 135 Or App 58, 60, 898 P2d 196 (1995), plaintiff appeals an order denying his request for a waiver or deferral of filing fees and sheriff's service fees. Plaintiff's opening brief, however, contains no argument, and we affirm for that reason. *See Smith v. Dept. of Corrections (A170818)*, 314 Or App 1, ___ P3d ___ (2021) (affirming denial of fee waiver where the appellant's brief contained no pertinent argument).
