2 Defendant was convicted of hindering prosecution, ORS 162.325, and challenges the trial court's denial of her motion for judgment of acquittal because the 3 4 state did not prove the allegations of the indictment. The issue presented here is identical to that in *State v. Hansen*, _____ Or App _____, ____ P3d _____ (Nov 7, 2012). Because 5 defendant was tried jointly with the defendant in Hansen, the evidentiary record is also 6 identical. For the reasons stated in *Hansen*, the trial court erred by denying defendant's 7 8 motion for judgment of acquittal. 9 Reversed.
