The court operations team member told Plaintiff that a request to reschedule the trial in this matter to a telephone proceeding must be made in writing to the court. The court did not receive a written request from Plaintiff to reschedule the trial in this matter to a telephone proceeding.

Plaintiff failed to appear for the trial scheduled in this matter on January 27, 2014. As of the date of this Final Decision of Dismissal, the court has received no further communication

from Plaintiff. Under such circumstances, the court concludes that this matter must be dismissed for lack of prosecution. Now, therefore,

IT IS THE DECISION OF THIS COURT that Plaintiff's Complaint is dismissed.
