This matter is before the court on its own motion to dismiss this case for want of prosecution.

A case management conference was scheduled on January 2, 2001, to consider plaintiffs' appeal. The letter advised that if plaintiffs did not provide a written explanation by January 16, 2001, for their failure to appear, the court would dismiss the appeal. As of this date, plaintiffs have not contacted the court. Under such circumstances, the court finds the appeal must be dismissed for want of prosecution. Now, therefore;
