This matter is before the court on Plaintiff's request, made during the May 15, 2002, initial case management conference, that the case be dismissed. Defendant does not object to the request, but had offered a slight reduction in the real market value (RMV) of the property, which was completed for the 2001-02 tax year. The recommended reduction would impact exception RMV, maximum assessed value (MAV), and assessed value (AV), resulting in a slight reduction in property taxes. Plaintiff twice repeated the request to dismiss the case. The court reluctantly accepts Plaintiff's request. Now, therefore,
