At the September 24, 2003, case management conference, the court agreed to place the case in abeyance pending the result of Plaintiff's appeal with the Internal Revenue Service. Plaintiff did not respond to a message left by court personnel on February 17, 2004, regarding the status of her federal appeal. As of this date, Plaintiff has not responded to the court's request. As a result, the court concludes the appeal should be dismissed. Now, therefore,

IT IS ADJUDGED that Plaintiff's appeal is reactivated and dismissed.
