This matter is before the court on its own motion to dismiss this case for want of prosecution.

On May 13, 2004, a telephonic case management conference was held to consider Plaintiff's appeal. At that time, Plaintiff stated that he would notify the court if he wanted to continue to trial or, in the alternative, withdraw his appeal. Subsequent telephone calls were made by Colleen Barnhart (Barnhart), of the court's staff, to Plaintiff regarding his appeal. In a letter dated July 6, 2004, Plaintiff advised the court "that I hereby withdraw my request for a Hearing Case Management *** scheduled to take place *** 7/28/04 at 10:30 a.m." (Emphasis in original.) circumstances, the court finds the appeal must be dismissed for want of prosecution. Now,
