This matter is before the court on Plaintiff's verbal Motion to Dismiss, made April 17, 2007, requesting that his Complaint be dismissed.

At the case management conference held on April 3, 2007, Defendant's Motion to Dismiss, filed March 8, 2007, was discussed. At the conclusion of the conference, Plaintiff requested time to review the statutory requirements of ORS<sup>1</sup> 305.288 and respond to Defendant's Answer. Plaintiff stated that his response would be submitted by April 13, 2007.

On April 17, 2007, a member of the court's staff telephoned Plaintiff, asking if he had mailed his response. Plaintiff stated that he was verbally withdrawing his appeal because he "does not have time to put a response to Defendant's Answer in writing."
