**PER CURIAM**

**AND NOW**, this 8th day of December, 2015, the Petition for Allowance of Appeal is **GRANTED**. The issues are:

- (1) Does the Commonwealth Court's opinion conflict with this Court's precedent in Bortz v. WCAB, [683 A.2d 259 (Pa. 1996),] which recognized the distinct conduct standards in workers' compensation and unemployment compensation adjudications?
- (2) Does the Commonwealth Court's opinion conflict with this Court's precedent in Harkness v. U[n]employment Comp. Bd. of Review 920 A.2d 162 (Pa. 2007),] which emphasized the prompt and informal nature of unemployment compensation proceedings and, therefore, presents a question of such substantial public importance as to require this Court's definitive resolution?
