**ORDER**

**PER CURIAM**

**AND NOW**, this 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2019, it being undisputed that the Commonwealth Court erred in its April 17, 2019 order in directing that Kim D. Williams be listed on the ballot as a Candidate for the Republican Nomination, the Petition for Allowance of Appeal is **GRANTED**, limited to that sole issue. The April 17, 2019 Commonwealth Court order is vacated and the case is **REMANDED** to the Commonwealth Court for entry of a corrected order. The Petition for Allowance of Appeal is **DENIED** in all other respects. Kim D. Williams remains on the ballot as a Candidate for the Democratic Nomination.

The Application for Extraordinary Relief is **DENIED**.
