**PER CURIAM**

**AND NOW**, this 13th day of May, 2021, the Petition for Allowance of Appeal is **GRANTED**, the Superior Court's order is **VACATED**, and this matter is **REMANDED** to the Superior Court for remand to the trial court with instructions to grant Petitioner's motion to dismiss the pending firearms charges. *See Commonwealth v.
