## <u>ORDER</u>

## **PER CURIAM**

AND NOW, this 4th day of December, 2013, the Petition for Allowance of Appeal is hereby **GRANTED**, **LIMITED TO** petitioner's first issue concerning the appropriate evidentiary standard to apply to her receipt of retirement benefits in determining voluntary retirement from the workforce. The order of the Commonwealth Court is **VACATED** as to this issue, and the case is **REMANDED** to the Commonwealth Court for reconsideration in light of our decision in <u>City of Pittsburgh v. WCAB (Robinson)</u>, 67 A.3d 1194, 1209 (Pa. 2013) ("There is no presumption of retirement arising from the fact that a claimant seeks or accepts a pension ...; rather, the worker's acceptance of a pension entitles the employer only to a permissive inference that the claimant has retired."). Allocatur is denied as to all other issues.

Jurisdiction relinquished.
