ORDER

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 11.07 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, the clerk of the trial court transmitted to this Court this application for a writ of habeas corpus. *Ex parte Young*, 418 S.W.2d 824, 826 (Tex. Crim. App. 1967). Applicant was convicted of sexual assault and sentenced to fifteen years' imprisonment. He did not appeal his conviction.

In a single ground, Applicant contends that he did not receive 100 days of pre-sentence credit. On May 14, 2013, the trial court signed an order finding that Applicant is entitled to 96 days of credit. We find that this is a subsequent application under Article 11.07, § 4 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. We also note that Applicant should file with the trial court a motion for a judgment *nunc pro tunc. Ex parte Ybarra*, 149 S.W.3d 147, 148-49 (Tex. Crim. App. 2004). This application is

dismissed.
