ORDER

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 11.07 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, the clerk of the trial court transmitted to this Court this application for a writ of habeas corpus. *Ex parte Young*, 418 S.W.2d 824, 826 (Tex. Crim. App. 1967). Applicant was convicted of ten counts of indecency with a child and sentenced to fifty years' imprisonment on each count. The Tenth Court of Appeals affirmed his convictions. *King v. State*, No. 10-09-00395-CR (Tex. App.—Waco 2010, pet. ref'd).

Applicant contends that trial counsel failed to: (1) object or timely object to testimony from Kimberly Green and Kristi Skains that directly or indirectly commented on the truthfulness of the complainant; (2) request instructions to disregard such testimony; and (3) elicit testimony from
