MEMORANDUM OPINION ON PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

Relator, Tony Martinez, M.D., asks this Court to issue a writ of mandamus against the Honorable Javier Alvarez, Judge of the County Court at Law No. 3 of El Paso County, in order to compel Judge Alvarez to enter judgment on the jury's verdict. In order to be entitled to mandamus relief, a relator must meet two requirements. First, the relator must show that the trial court clearly abused its discretion. *In re Prudential Insurance Company of America*, 148 S.W.3d 124, 135 (Tex. 2004). Second, the relator must demonstrate he has no adequate remedy by appeal. *Id.* at 135-36. Since Relator filed his mandamus petition, the trial court has entered judgment. Accordingly, we dismiss this mandamus proceeding as moot.
