



In accordance with Rule 37.3(b), the Clerk of the Court notified Appellant by letter regarding his failure to make financial arrangements to pay for the clerk's record and advised him that the appeal would be dismissed for want of prosecution unless he responded within ten days and showed grounds for continuing the appeal. *See* TEX.R.APP.P. 37.3(b). Appellant has not filed any written response or otherwise showed that grounds exist for the appeal to be continued. Pursuant to Rules 37.3(b), we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* TEX.R.APP.P. 37.3(b)(authorizing appellate court to dismiss appeal for want of prosecution if the clerk's record is not filed because appellant failed to make payment arrangements for preparation of the clerk's record).
