MEMORANDUM OPINION

Reginald C. Gilbert, acting *pro se*, appealed the trial court’s “Order Denying Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus Seeking Bail Reduction,” signed on June 6, 2022.¹ On July 22, 2022, this Court received notice updating the contact and representation information for Gilbert. On August 31, 2022, Gilbert, through new counsel, filed his “Appellant’s Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss Appeal” in this Court. *See* TEX.R.APP.P. 42.2 (governing voluntary dismissals in criminal cases). Gilbert and counsel both signed the written motion. *See id.* The motion is granted.

CONCLUSION

The appeal is dismissed.
