MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Ruben Rodriguez, Jr., filed a pro se notice of appeal on September 24, 2013. We note that Appellant has also failed to pay for the clerk's record and the reporter's record.

Because Appellant has failed to pay the required filing fee in this appeal, we dismiss the appeal. TEX. R. APP. P. 5, 42.3.
