MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before Justices O'Neill, Lang-Miers, and Evans
Opinion by Justice Evans

Relator contends the trial court violated a ministerial duty by not holding a hearing on his petition for writ of habeas corpus and by denying that petition. The facts and issues are well known to the parties, so we need not recount them herein. Based on the record before us, we conclude relator has not shown he is entitled to the relief requested. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(a); *Simon v. Levario*, 306 S.W.3d 318, 320-21 (Tex. Crim. App. 2009) (orig. proceeding); *State of Tex. ex rel. Hill v. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Dist.*, 34 S.W.3d 924, 927 (Tex. Crim. App. 2001) (orig. proceeding). Accordingly, we **DENY** relator's petition for writ of mandamus.
