MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before Chief Justice Wright, Justice Lang-Miers, and Justice Myers Opinion by Justice Lang-Miers

Demond D. Wilsonjohnson¹ waived a jury and pleaded guilty to engaging in organized criminal activity and aggravated robbery with a deadly weapon. *See* TEX. PENAL CODE ANN. §§ 29.03(a), 71.02(a) (West 2011 & Supp. 2016). After finding appellant guilty, the trial court assessed punishment at ten years' imprisonment in each case. On appeal, appellant's attorney filed a brief in which she concludes the appeals are wholly frivolous and without merit. The brief meets the requirements of *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). The brief presents a professional evaluation of the record showing why, in effect, there are no arguable grounds to advance. *See High v. State*, 573 S.W.2d 807, 811–12 (Tex. Crim. App. [Panel Op.] 1978). Counsel delivered a copy of the brief to appellant. We advised appellant of his right to file a pro

se response, but he did not file a pro se response. See Kelly v. State, 436 S.W.3d 313, 319–21

(Tex. Crim. App. 2014) (identifying duties of appellate courts and counsel in Anders cases).

We have reviewed the record and counsel's brief. See Bledsoe v. State, 178 S.W.3d 824,

826–27 (Tex. Crim. App. 2005) (explaining appellate court's duty in Anders cases). We agree

the appeals are frivolous and without merit. We find nothing in the record that might arguably

support the appeals.

We affirm the trial court's judgments.
