MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before Chief Justice Wright, Justice Lang-Miers, and Justice Myers
Opinion by Justice Lang-Miers

Demond D. Wilsonjohnson¹ waived a jury and pleaded guilty to engaging in organized criminal activity and aggravated robbery with a deadly weapon. *See* TEX. PENAL CODE ANN. §§ 29.03(a), 71.02(a) (West 2011 & Supp. 2016). After finding appellant guilty, the trial court assessed punishment at ten years' imprisonment in each case. On appeal, appellant's attorney filed a brief in which she concludes the appeals are wholly frivolous and without merit. The brief meets the requirements of *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). The brief presents a professional evaluation of the record showing why, in effect, there are no arguable grounds to advance. *See High v. State*, 573 S.W.2d 807, 811–12 (Tex. Crim. App. [Panel Op.] 1978). Counsel delivered a copy of the brief to appellant. We advised appellant of his right to file a pro

se response, but he did not file a pro se response. *See Kelly v. State*, 436 S.W.3d 313, 319–21 (Tex. Crim. App. 2014) (identifying duties of appellate courts and counsel in *Anders* cases).

We have reviewed the record and counsel’s brief. *See Bledsoe v. State*, 178 S.W.3d 824, 826–27 (Tex. Crim. App. 2005) (explaining appellate court’s duty in *Anders* cases). We agree the appeals are frivolous and without merit. We find nothing in the record that might arguably support the appeals.

We affirm the trial court’s judgments.
