Before the Court is relator's December 28, 2016 petition for writ of mandamus in which relator asks the Court to order the district clerk to provide relator a copy of the trial court's orders and clerk's index pages. We do not have mandamus jurisdiction over a district clerk unless the clerk is interfering with our appellate jurisdiction. Tex. Gov't Code § 22.221(a)-(b) (West 2004); *In re Wilkerson*, 05-16-00322-CV, 2016 WL 1320815, at *1 (Tex. App.—Dallas Apr. 5, 2016, orig. proceeding) (citing *In re Simpson*, 997 S.W.2d 939, 939 (Tex. App.—Waco 1999, orig. proceeding)). No appeal is pending, and our jurisdiction is not in jeopardy. Accordingly, we dismiss the petition for want of jurisdiction.
