MEMORANDUM OPINION

On December 19, 2017, after determining appellant's brief failed to comply with the requirements of Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 38.1, we directed appellant to file a corrected brief. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.1, 38.9. We cautioned appellant at the time that failure to comply by December 29, 2017 could result in dismissal of the appeal without further notice. *See id.* 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b),(c). At appellant's request, we subsequently extended the deadline to January 29, 2018 and then to February 28, 2018. Despite the extensions, the brief has not been filed. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal. *See id.* 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b),(c).
