MEMORANDUM OPINION

The clerk's record in this case is past due. By letter dated July 18, 2018, we informed appellant the clerk's record had not been filed because appellant had not paid for the clerk's record. We directed appellant to provide, within ten days, written verification of payment or arrangements to pay for the clerk's record or written verification appellant had been found entitled to proceed without payment of costs.
