**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

The clerk's record in this case is overdue. By letter dated November 3, 2021, we informed appellant the clerk's record had not been filed because appellant had not paid for the clerk's record. We directed appellant to provide, within ten days, verification that (1) she had either paid for or made arrangements to pay for the record, or (2) she is entitled to proceed without payment of costs.
