MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Betty Joyce Williams has neither established indigence, nor paid or

made arrangement to pay the clerk's fee for preparing the clerk's record. See TEX.

R. APP. P. 20.1 (listing requirements for establishing indigence), 37.3(b) (allowing

dismissal of appeal if no clerk's record filed due to appellant's fault). After being notified that this appeal was subject to dismissal, appellant Betty Joyce Williams did not adequately respond. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(c) (allowing involuntary dismissal of case).

The appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution for failure to pay or make arrangements to pay the clerk's fee. All pending motions are denied.
