MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellants Ladipo Kolawole Wasiu and Deloise Wilson-Ladipo have neither established indigence, nor paid or made arrangements to pay the clerk's fee for

preparing the clerk's record. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 20.1 (listing requirements for establishing indigence), 37.3(b) (allowing dismissal of appeal if no clerk's record filed due to appellant's fault). After being notified that this appeal was subject to dismissal, appellants Ladipo Kolawole Wasiu and Deloise Wilson-Ladipo did not adequately respond. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(c) (allowing involuntary dismissal of case).

The appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution for failure to pay or make arrangements to pay the clerk's fee for preparing the clerk's record. All pending motions are denied.
