MEMORANDUM OPINION

By petition for writ of injunction, relator, George Johnson, challenges the Justice of the Peace Court's¹ denial of his motion to dismiss. We have no general writ power over a justice of the peace. *See* TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. § 22.221(b) (Vernon 2004); *Easton v. Franks*, 842 S.W.2d 772, 773-74 (Tex. App.—Houston [1st Dist.]
