MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, General Carlos Harris, has filed in this Court a petition for writ of mandamus complaining that respondent¹ has not ruled on a nunc pro tunc motion filed in trial court cause number 1116884. On December 10, 2009, respondent filed a response to relator's petition which states:
