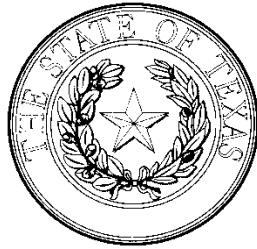

MEMORANDUM OPINION
