MEMORANDUM OPINION

By petition for writ of mandamus, relator, The Cadle Company, sought relief from the trial court's order denying a motion to quash a subpoena. On January 14, 2011, relator moved to dismiss the petition for writ of mandamus, stating that relator no longer desires to pursue mandamus relief.¹ No opinion has issued.

The underlying case is *The Cadle Company v. Roy H. Bray*, No. 579,602-801 in the County Court at Law No. 1 of Harris County, Texas, the Honorable Jack Cagle presiding.
