MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant sought habeas corpus relief in the trial court seeking a reduction in the amount of his bail. After the trial court denied habeas corpus relief, appellant

filed appeals in this Court. Since that time, appellant has posted bond rendering his appeals moot. Accordingly, appellant has filed a motion to dismiss the appeals. More than 10 days have elapsed, and no objection has been filed. No opinion has issued. Accordingly, the motion is granted, and the appeals are **dismissed**. TEX. R. APP. P. 42.2(a).
