**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator, Hartford Casualty Insurance Company, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus, challenging the trial court's order denying relator's motion to compel appraisal and motion to stay proceedings pending appraisal. While relator's petition was pending, the underlying case was dismissed with prejudice

because the parties reached a settlement.<sup>1</sup> Relator informed the Court that it no longer seeks mandamus relief.

Accordingly, we **dismiss** relator's petition for writ of mandamus.
