**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator, Thomas Lee Fifer, has filed a pro se petition for writ of mandamus, complaining that the trial court has failed to rule on his motion for judgment nunc pro tunc.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> A jury found relator guilty of the offense of aggravated assault in *State v. Fifer*, No. 1117100, in the 184th District Court of Harris County, Texas, the Honorable Jan Krockner presiding. This Court modified the trial court's judgment to clarify the Penal Code provision under which relator was convicted, and then affirmed the trial court's judgment as modified. See *Fifer v. State*, No. 01-07-00894-CR, 2008
