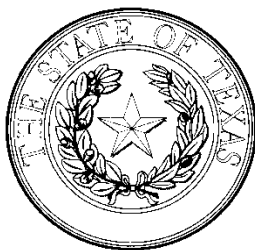

MEMORANDUM OPINION¹

By petition for writ of mandamus, relators Dupuy Associates, P.C. and Christopher Dupuy, complain that the trial judge abused his discretion by refusing to grant their motion for summary judgment and “fail[ing] to follow the law, the
