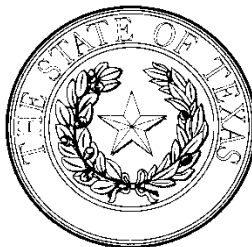

Original Proceeding on Petition for Writ of Mandamus

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Ted Lawrence Robertson, petitioned for writ of mandamus asking that we declare void the nunc pro tunc judgment rendered by the trial court on February 11, 2009. He further requests that we order the trial court to vacate or set aside that judgment.¹
