# MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

To the Honorable Justice of Said Court:

Now comes, Victor Anthony Charles, Appellant, hereinafter Charles, by and through himself in the above and numbered and entitled cause and files this motion for extension of time, in support Charles submits the following;

# Procedural History

On or about November 21, 2012, Charles received notice from the clerk of this court the clerk's record had been filed with this court.

On November 25, 2012, Charles filed his Motion for the clerk's record and further notified this court in said motion that as of November 25, 2012, Charles had not been notified of the trial court's decision in regards to the contest filed by the Harris County District Clerk's office contesting Charles' status as indigent. In addition to this issue, the Harris County District clerk's office filed their contest on August 24, 2012, and Charles filed his reply on August 28, 2012.

II
