

MEMORANDUM OPINION

In this original proceeding, relator Christopher W. Stoddart seeks mandamus relief against Chris Daniel, the District Clerk of Harris County, alleging that Daniel has failed to file his divorce and denied him access to the courts.¹ We deny the petition for writ of mandamus.
