## **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Appellant, Amiko Kauderer, has filed a "Notice of Withdrawal of Appeal," in which she states that she "withdraws her notice of appeal." The Court construes this notice as a motion to dismiss the appeal. No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. Further, although appellant failed to include a certificate of conference, more than 10 days have passed and no party has responded to the notice. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a).

Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). We dismiss all other pending motions as moot.
