MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Forrest King, has neither paid the required fees nor established indigence for purposes of appellate costs. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 5, 20.1; *see also* TEX. Appeals, and Before the Judicial Panel on Multi-District Litigation, Misc. Docket No. 13-9127 (Tex. Aug. 16, 2013). After being notified by the Clerk of this Court on June 5, 2014, that this appeal was subject to dismissal, appellant did not respond. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 5, 42.3(c).

Accordingly, we **dismiss** the appeal for nonpayment of all required fees and for want of prosecution. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 5, 42.3(b), (c). We dismiss any pending motions as moot.
