MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Bob Bennett a/k/a Robert S. Bennett, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus, requesting that we order the Respondent, identified as the Honorable John Wooldridge, “to provide adequate notice for a new recusal hearing, and to vacate the all [sic] orders entered since the recusal hearing.”¹ In response, the real

parties in interest request that we grant sanctions against relator pursuant to Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 52.11.

We **deny** the petition for writ of mandamus. We further **deny** the real parties in interest's request for sanctions against relator.
