MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Artis Charles Harrell, an inmate proceeding *pro se*, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus seeking to compel the respondent trial court to vacate its order sustaining the district clerk's contest to his affidavit of indigence, claiming that the contest was untimely filed.¹
